Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.

WHEREAS, the central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under Rule 3 of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 Whereas all industries are required to install and regularly operate the requisite pollution control facilities to comply with the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants; and

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing and Bleaching industries have been identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof ; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter and web camera may be installed in case of units achieving zero liquid discharge ZLD by march 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, M/s K. S. M. Hosiery, G-2, G-3 Rooma Industrial Area, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh, (here in after referred as 'the Unit') is textile unit and;

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 09.06.2017 under section 5 of Environment (P) Act to the Unit for compliance of the following directions:

1. The Unit shall remain closed.
2. The unit shall install the Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System and connect with CPCB server before resuming
3. The unit shall obtain valid consent from UPPCB under Air and Water Act.
4. After completion of the above said measures, the uit shall report to CPCB and seek permission from CPCB before resumption of their manufacturing operations.

AND WHEREAS, a team deputed by CPCB carried out inspection of M/s K. S. M Hosiery, G-2, G-3 Rooma Industrial Area, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh, on dated 27.06.2017 to verify the compliance status of closure direction issued and following observations were made:

1. On the day of inspection the unit was found operational and dyeing work was going on which is a violation of the closure direction dated 09.06.2017.
2. On the day of inspection, the ETP was found non-operational.
3. The OCEMS was not installed.
4. The Unit has not provided copies of consent issued under Water and Air Act 1986.
5. The ETP was installed recently and installation of an EMF at the outlet of ETP was under process.
6. Water meter was not installed at water abstraction point.
7. Logbooks were not maintained for operation of ETP, consumption of chemical and energy meter etc.
8. The unit does not have permission of CGWA for ground water abstraction.

AND WHEREAS, the unit has not closed down its manufacturing operation on its own, which is violation of CPCB directions dated 09/06/2017 issued under section 5 of E (P) Act, 1986, and appropriate legal action shall be initiated separately and;

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit is hereby directed to comply with the following directions.

1. The Unit, **M/s K. S. M Hosiery, G-2, G-3 Roama Industrial Area, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh** shall closed down its all manufacturing process and not to resume manufacture operation till compliance with the directions dated 09.06.2017.
2. The unit shall install OCEMS and will register for connectivity to CPCB portal.
3. The unit shall submit copies of valid consent issued under Air Act and Water Act.
4. The Unit shall operate the ETP regularly.
5. The Unit shall maintain logbooks for fresh water consumption, waste water discharge, ETP operations, consumption of chemical, energy meter and disposal of solid waste generated.
6. The unit shall install water meter at extraction point.
7. The unit shall inform to CPCB about closure of the Unit immediately and shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of their manufacturing operations.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB may initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
