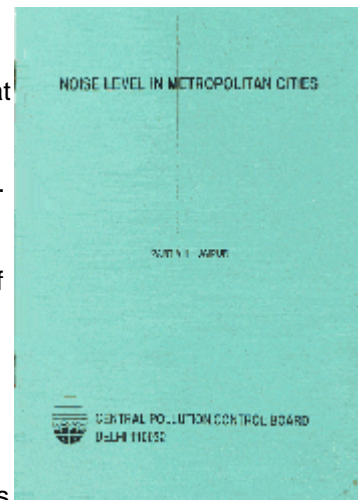
Foreword
