Sub: Direction under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, M/s Diamond Cements, (Prop: Heidelberg Cement India Ltd), Damoh, M.P. was jointly inspected by RD-Bhopal and Madhya Pradesh Pollution Control Board during March 2-6, 2017, in the presence of representative of the complainant and made following recommendations:

Clinkerisation Unit at Narsingharh

1. The Industry should provide measures for controlling of NOx emissions to meet the prescribed norms.
2. The industry should improve the housekeeping and control the fugitive emission at coal storage area and secondary crusher area.
3. The industry should cover the Lime stone piles properly to control fugitive emissions during heavy winds etc.
4. The Unit should provide concreted/pucca roads around lime stone storage stock piles area, near coal storage area and old time office area to control fugitive emissions.
5. The industry should ensure that the on-line continuous emission monitoring system should be connected with MPPCB server.

Grinding Unit at Imlai

1. The Unit should control fugitive emission (leakage) at Clinker storage stock piles (12000 Ton and 25000 Ton) area and improve housekeeping by making a pucca road.
2. The Unit should improve Housekeeping at Cement mill No. 1 area.
3. The Unit should control Fugitive emission and improve housekeeping at line tipping and clinker intake hoper area.
4. The Unit should make pucca road around line tipping and clinker intake hoper area.

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5. On-line continuous emission monitoring system should be properly connected with MPPCB server.

Limestone Mines at Patharia

1. Approach road from plants (approx. 22 km) to mines should be made cemented for control of fugitive emission being spread to nearby village area.

WHEREAS, show cause notice for closure cum direction dated 22.03.2017 was issued to M/s Diamond Cements, (Prop: Heidelberg Cement India Ltd), Damoh, M.P. on above grounds in compliance of which the unit submitted a the time bound action plan to undertake remedial measures has been obtained by the unit vide letter dated 01.08.2017, which has been analysed.

WHEREAS, the direction to comply with new emission standards notified vide G.S.R. 496(E) dated May 09, 2016 which include NOx parameter has been issued to the unit vide letter dated September 06, 2017.

WHEREAS, the time schedule to construct pucca road as proposed, beyond December 2017 is not acceptable.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, municipal corporation, municipal council, cantonment board, to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and other standards and norms;

Now, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and exercising the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, following directions are hereby issued to M/s Diamond Cements, (Prop: Heidelberg Cement India Ltd), Damoh, M.P. to be implemented by 31.12.2017:

For Clinkerization Unit at Narsingarh:

1. That the unit shall provide concreted/pucca roads around lime stone storage stock piles area, near coal storage area and old time office area to control fugitive emissions.



For Grinding Unit at Imlai:

2. The unit shall provide concreted/pucca roads around line tipping and clinker intake hoper area to control fugitive emission and improve housekeeping.

Action taken report shall be submitted to this office for the above, failing which, it will be presumed that you have nothing to say in this regard and CPCB will be constrained to take action as deemed fit under the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
