Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 – reg.

WHEREAS, Dye & Dye Intermediate units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, TSS, BOD, COD, Cr, & Flow parameters in Dye & Dye Intermediate industries; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of Units with zero liquid discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board, Regional Directorate, Vadodara inspected **M/s Ashu Organics (I) Pvt. Ltd (Unit No. II), Plot No. W-48, W-49, Morivali MIDC, Phase-1, Ambernath, Dist: Thane, Maharashtra-421505** on August 09, 2017 as per Hon'ble NGT Pune Order; and

WHEREAS, Effluent analysis results indicate that the unit is not complying with Maharashtra State Pollution Control Board standards for COD (2486 > 250 mg/l), BOD (858 > 100 mg/l), TSS (174 > 100 mg/l), Oil & Grease (55.6 > 10 mg/l) that may cause a grave injury to the environment; and

WHEREAS, the inspection team observed that the Unit stored drums of spent acid & solvent in open area; and

WHEREAS, the unit has not provided flow meter at the ETP; and

WHEREAS, it has been verified by the IT division of the CPCB on 27.10.2017 that the unit has not provided the connectivity of the online monitoring system to the Central Pollution Control Board.

WHEREAS, as per Section 4, Sub section (5) of The Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986; In case where the Central Government is of the opinion that in view of the likelihood of a grave injury to the environment it is not expedient to provide an opportunity to file objections against the proposed direction, it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, issue directions without providing such an opportunity; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5

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of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW, THEREFORE, based on all facts and observations, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **M/s Ashu Organics (I) Pvt. Ltd; (Unit No. II), Plot No. W-48, W-49, Morivali MIDC, Phase-1, Ambernath, Dist: Thane, Maharashtra-421505** is hereby directed to close all manufacturing / production activities until it complies with the following directions:

1. The Unit shall upgrade its Effluent Treatment Plant and shall submit ETP adequacy report from any reputed Government Organisation, so that the treated effluent may conform to Maharashtra State Pollution Control Board prescribed standards.
2. The Unit shall manage & dispose hazardous waste along with proper record maintenance in accordance with Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
3. The unit shall install online flow meter & web camera and provide its online data connectivity to CPCB.


In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986 will be taken.
