**Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.**

**WHEREAS**, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, there is need to inculcate habit of self monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent & emission monitoring devices; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s K Vinayak Knitwear Industries, (here in after referred as 'the Unit') located at Plot no. C-21, Rooma Industrial Area, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh, is a textile dyeing and bleaching unit involved in the processing of Hosiery clothes; and

**WHEREAS**, inspection of the unit was conducted on April 12, 2017 and May 08, 2017 by representative of CPCB to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms and the following observations were made:

- (i) Main gate was closed. The Unit reported closed since Feb, 2017.
- (ii) Consent validity expired;
- (iii) Two bore wells used for water supply are not fitted with flow meter;
- (iv) ETP was not functioning and measuring devices to the ETP is not installed and
- (v) Flow meters procured but not installed to Tube Wells and ETP.

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued closure direction dated: 29.05.2017 to the unit, and

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit was inspected by CPCB team on 20.06.2017 and observed the following:-

- (i) The Unit was operational in violation the CPCB closure direction issued on 29.05.2017.
- (ii) Multiple by pass of untreated industrial effluent was found, ETP was found non operational.
- (iii) OCEMS not installed at ETP outlet,
- (iv) The EMF meter at Bore well was not installed.

**WHEREAS**, the unit was inspected by CPCB on 20.06.2017 and unit found operational, indicating that unit has not closed down its manufacturing operation on its own, which is violation of CPCB direction dated 29.05.2017 issued under section 5 of E(P) Act, 1986, and appropriate legal action shall be initiated separately; and

**WHEREAS**, The unit's vide letters dated: 10.07.2017, 24.08.2017 and 28.08.2017 were examined and following observations made.

- i. The unit has installed OCEMS and provided connectivity with CPCB server.
- ii. The unit has submitted self certificate mentioning that it has stopped the operations with effect from 10.07.2017.
- iii. The unit has submitted notarized Affidavit dated 14.09.2017, in the required format.
- iv. The unit has applied for consent under Air and Water Act.
- v. The unit has applied for NOC from CGWA for extraction of ground water.

**WHEREAS**, the unit is connected with CETP, Rooma, Kanpur for conveyance treatment of effluent; and

**WHEREAS**, UPSIDC, vide letter dt 14.08.2017 informed that the maintenance work of CETP has been completed, CETP is ready for commissioning and requested for revoke of closure issued to member unit to ensure available of effluent for trial run of CETP.

**WHEREAS**, three member revocation committee in its meeting held on 31/10/2017 at CPCB office, has recommended for the revoke of closure directions.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the closure directions dated 29.05.2017 is revoked and the unit **M/s K Vinayak Knitwear Industries, Plot No. C-21, Rooma Industrial Area, Kanpur**, Uttar Pradesh and hereby directed to comply the following:-

- (i) The unit shall immediately inform to CPCB on resumption of production operations.
- (ii) The unit shall submit effluent analysis report from an EPA recognised laboratory to CPCB within 30 days from resuming the operation.
- (iii) the Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit will comply the inlet to CETP standards prescribed by the UPPCB / SPV and the effluent is further treated in the CETP as per the standards notified by Central Government vide Gazette notification dated 01.01.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB may initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
