Revoke Direction under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 15.05.2017 under Section 5 of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 to the M/s Champa Dyeing Pvt. Ltd., Gyanpur Road, Bhadohi, Uttar Pradesh, (herein after referred as the Unit) for compliance of following directions;

1. The unit shall stop all wet process operations immediately till installation and commissioning of Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) and provide connectivity to the CPCB server for continuous 24x7 data transmission.
2. The unit shall report to CPCB about stopping of wet process operations immediately.
3. The unit seek permission from CPCB before resumption of wet process operations.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 17.05.2017 under Section 5 of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit for compliance of following;

1. The unit shall close down all the plant operations with immediate effect.
2. The unit shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operations in compliance of the direction immediately on receipt of this direction.
3. The unit shall install the OCEMS.
4. The unit shall obtained valid consent from UPPCB under Air and Water Acts. As per consent order issued by UPPCB, the unit is allowed to discharge Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) outlet to irrigation/ drain.
5. After completion of the above said measures, the unit shall report to CPCB and seek permission from CPCB before resumption of their manufacturing operation.

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AND WHEREAS, the Unit replies vide letters dated 28.09.2017 and 09.10.2017 were examined and following observations are made;

1. The unit has stopped all the operations with effect from 29.05.2017 in compliance of the closure direction issued by CPCB.
2. The unit has submitted details of registration and connectivity of the OCEMS with the CPCB portal and server.
3. The unit has submitted valid consents under Air and Water Acts with validity upto 31.12.2017 and submitted membership certificate for Hazardous Waste Management.
4. The unit has submitted application for NOC from CGWA for groundwater extraction.
5. The unit has submitted the Self-Certificate as per CPCB format and undertaking on stamp paper.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three-member committee in its meeting held on 31.10.2017 examined the replies of the unit and recommended for revoke of closure directions dated 15.05.2017 and 17.05.2017.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the closure directions dated 15.05.2017 and 17.05.2017 are revoked and the unit M/s Champa Dyeing Pvt. Ltd., Gyanpur Road, Bhadohi, Uttar Pradesh is hereby directed to comply with the following directions;

1. The unit shall resume the manufacturing operation and inform immediately to CPCB; and
2. The Unit shall ensure all time compliance of the standards of treated effluent as per Gazette notification dated 10.10.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986; and
3. The Unit shall submit the treated effluent analysis report by the laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days from the date of resumption of operation.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
