Directions Under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the tannery and leather industries are also identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly in to ambient Air and Water, having potential to threat to cause adverse effects on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s, Tanners Point, 129-A1, Block-C, Ahamad Nagar, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a Tannery industry and was inspected by a team of officials authorized by CPCB on 04.04.2017 to verify the compliance status; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued Closure direction dated 23.06.2017 under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit; and

WHEREAS, unit reply vide letter dated nil was examined and following observations are:

1. The unit has installed OCEMS and provided connectivity and registration
2. The unit has valid consent under Air & Water Acts up to 31.12.2017.
3. The unit has provided undertaking on stamp paper.
4. The unit has registration on CPCB registration portal.
5. The connectivity of the unit is visible on CPCB portal.

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF &CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three member committee in its meeting held on 31.10.2017 examined and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume operation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers delegated under the Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the Chairman of CPCB, the closure direction issued to the unit M/s. *Tanners Point, 129-A1, Block-C, Ahamad Nagar, Jajmau*, Kanpur dated 22.06.2017 is hereby directed to comply with following directions:

1. The unit shall resume operation only with seeking valid authorization under Hazardous waste (Management & Trans boundary Movement) Rules 2016.
2. The unit shall comply with the consent conditions as issued by the UPPCB.
3. The unit shall ensure to provide continuous OCEMS data on CPCB server.
4. The unit shall provide ETP treated effluent sample analysis report from EPA recognised lab within 30 days from the date of resumption.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.


