Directions Under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued show cause notice for closure dated 31.03.2016 to the Unit in compliance to directions issued by CPCB under Sec 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 in respect of GPI with respect to installation of online effluent monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, M/s Leyoan Global Ltd, A-5,6 Industrial Area, LTP, Banther , Unnao, Uttar Pradesh, (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a Tannery industry and was inspected by a team of officials authorized by CPCB on 12.04.2017 to verify the compliance status and following observations were made:

1. The unit found operational on the day of inspection and has installed capacity of 7800Kg/day.
2. The unit has no valid consent to operate under Air and Water Act from 31.12.2016.
3. Total of 223m³/d water is being withdrawn through bore well.
4. Waste water generation is 220 m³/day, which is 28.5 m³/t of hide processing.
5. The unit is has installed individual CRP. Detail of CETP membership is not available.
6. Unit has installed OCEMS and has provided connectivity with CPCB server with registration.
7. The analysis report of treated effluent sample of PETP showed pH-8.5(as against 6.5 to 9.0), TSS-560 mg/l (as against 600 mg/l) and Chromium as Cr-1.51 mg/l (as against 2.0 mg/l).

AND WHEREAS, the unit was issued direction under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 dated 16.06.2017; and

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WHEREAS, the unit reply dated 10.07.2017, 26.08.2017 & 04.09.2017 were examined and observed that:

1. The unit has consent to operate issued by UPPCB valid up to 30.06.2017.
2. The production and water consumption have been reduced by 50% of consented value.
3. Chrome recovery plant is working efficiently.
4. Unit is a CETP member and has installed OCEMS that is connected with CPCB server.
5. Effluent sample meets the standard prescribed for CETP inlet.
6. The unit has provided self certificate in the required format.

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF &CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three member committee in its meeting held on 31.10.2017 examined and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume operation.


AND NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under the Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the direction dated 16.06.2017 issued to the unit M/s Leayan Global Ltd, A-5, 6 Industrial Area, LTP, Banther, Unnao, Uttar Pradesh, is hereby revoked and directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall resume operation and inform to CPCB regarding the resumption of operation.
2. The unit shall comply with the consent conditions as issued by the UPPCB.
3. The unit shall ensure to provide continuous OCEMS data connectivity on CPCB server immediately on resumption of operations.
4. The unit shall provide ETP treated effluent sample analysis report from lab recognised under EPA,1986 within 15 days from the date of resumption.

In case of default in compliance with the above direction CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provision of Environment (Protection) Act,1986.
