**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s **Famous Tanners** (*hereafter referred to as Unit*) was inspected on 18.04.2017. The Unit is engaged in tanning process (raw to finish) with processing capacity 30 hides per day (750 kg/day).

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued closure direction on dated 22 June, 2017 to the unit for installation of OCEMS and registration on industrial portal of CPCB for OCEMS; and

**WHEREAS**, unit reply vide letter dated 18.08.2017 was examined and observed found that:

1. The unit is registered on CPCB portal.
2. The unit has provided self certificate.
3. The unit has provided undertaking on stamp paper.
4. The unit has provided the photographs of OCEMS (flow meter) installed in the unit.
5. Unit has provided the photocopy of electricity disconnection slip.

**WHEREAS**, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF &CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, the Three member committee in its meeting held on 31.10.2017 examined and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume operation and shall provide the data connectivity on CPCB server within 15 days from the date of resumption.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers delegated under the Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the Chairman of CPCB, the closure direction issued to the unit **M/s Famous Tanners**, 163/156, Jajmau Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh dated 22.06.2017 is **hereby** directed to comply with following directions:

- 1) The Unit shall resume operations and inform to CPCB regarding the resumption of operations.
- 2) The unit shall provide continuous OCEMS data connectivity on CPCB server within 15 days from date of resumption of operations.
- 3) The Unit shall provide treated effluent analysis report by the laboratory recognized under the EPA, 1986 within 30 days from the resumption of operation.
- 4) The unit shall comply with consented conditions as issued by UPPCB.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.


