**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and other standards and norms; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Banwari Paper Mills Ltd., Ram Nagar Road, Kashipur (Udham Singh Nagar) Uttarakhand (hereinafter referred as 'the Unit') is a waste paper based mill and engaged in Writing & Printing Paper with an installed capacity of 60 TPD; and

**WHEREAS**, the Unit was inspected by the officials of CPCB on December 26, 2017 and the unit was found non complying with respect to TSS- 61 mg/l (as against the norms of 50 mg/l) and BOD- 32 mg/l (as against the norms of 30 mg/l); and

**WHEREAS**, the unit was issued letter dated 13.02.2017 for implementation of pollution control measures; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit reply vide letter dated 27.02.2017 was examined; and

**WHEREAS**, the Unit was inspected by the officials of CPCB on July 13, 2017 and made following observations are made:

- The unit & ETP both were operational. The unit is engaged in production of writing and printing paper with installed capacity of 60 TPD and production capacity 56-57 TPD using waste paper as raw material.
- The unit meets fresh water demand from 02 numbers of bore well installed with water meter. The fresh water consumption of the unit is 14.4 KL/MT for the month of June, 2017.
- The treated effluent of the unit is discharged in Nakatiya drain to Behla river which meets river Kosi and ultimately river to Ramganga..
- OCEMS is installed in the unit and is connected with CPCB server.

- The unit has valid consent under Air Act, Water Act & Hazardous waste Authorization up to 31.03.2018.
- The ETP of the unit is upgraded up to tertiary treatment (DMF) facility.
- Analysis report of ETP treated effluent shows: pH 7.31; **BOD- 46 mg/l** (as against the norms of 30mg/l); COD- 158 mg/l (as against the norms of 250 mg/l); **TSS-62 mg/l** (as against the norms of 50 mg/l).

**It is evident that the unit is discharging partially treated effluent and posing risk to surface water quality.**

**AND NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the **unit M/s Banwari Paper Mills Ltd., Ram Nagar Road, Kashipur (Udham Singh Nagar) Uttarakhand** is hereby directed to comply with following directions:

1. The unit shall close down all the manufacturing operations immediately and inform to CPCB.
2. The unit shall submit & implement a time bound action plan for augmentation & up-gradation of ETP system so as to treat the entire effluent generated from the operation at consented capacity to meet the notified effluent discharge standards.
3. The unit shall seek prior permission from CPCB for resumption of operation at consented capacity.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
