CLOSURE DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under Rule 3 of the Environmental (Protection) Rules, 1986 Whereas, all industries are required to install and regularly operate the requisite pollution control facilities to comply with the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants; and

WHEREAS, Tannery industries have been identified as one of the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online emission monitoring system and online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, COD, BOD, TSS and Flow parameters in Tannery industries; and

WHEREAS, Chairman, CPCB, in exercise of the powers delegated under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 issued Show-cause Notice on 31.03.2016 to all member tanneries of the Common Effluent Treatment Plants at Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh as to why directions be not issued to close their manufacturing operations and disconnecting their electricity supply till the CETP is upgraded, so as to comply with the prescribed standards, including those related to primary treatment; and

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WHEREAS, M/s Naffes Leather Finishers (Fida Husain Ki Tannery), 24-A, 175/158-A, Budhia Ghat, Jajmau Kanpur, PIN 208010, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a leather processing unit and ;

WHEREAS, a team from CPCB carried out inspection of M/s Naffes Leather Finishers (Fida Husain Ki Tannery), 24-A, 175/158-A, Budhia Ghat, Jajmau Kanpur, PIN 208010, Uttar Pradesh on 30.05.2017.

Important findings of the inspection are as below:

1. The unit was found operational on the day of inspection.
2. The unit has installed electromagnetic flow meter and continuous monitoring system and has set up connectivity with CPCB server.
3. The unit has provided details of online flow measurement system including registration.
4. The unit is not complying to the standards of PETP discharge. The value of pH and Total Chromium in PETP effluent was found exceeding specified limits (pH 4.82 against permissible value of 6.0-9.0 and Total Chromium 7.76 mg/l against maximum permissible value of 2.0 mg/l).
5. The unit has submitted application for seeking permission of CGWB for ground water withdrawal.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and exercising powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are issued for compliance:

1. The unit, **M/s Naffes Leather Finishers (Fida Husain Ki Tannery), 24-A, 175/158-A, Budhia Ghat, Jajmau Kanpur, PIN 208010, Uttar Pradesh shall close all manufacturing operations immediately.**
2. The unit shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operation and compliance of directions.
3. The unit shall not commence operation without maintenance/upgradation of Primary Effluent Treatment Plant (PETP) and compliance of the discharge of PETP effluent.
4. The unit shall not commence operation without valid consents and hazardous waste authorization from State Pollution Control Board.
5. The unit shall maintain proper logbooks for all the relevant activities.
6. The unit shall obtain permission from CPCB before resumption of any manufacturing operations.

The compliance of above directions shall be submitted to this office **within 15 days of the receipt of the directions.** In case of default in compliance with the above direction, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.


