Subject: Integrity pledge – reg.

To ensure that we are not part of any corrupt practice and we tackle instances of corruption with utmost strictness, every government servant has the duty to put in place safeguards, integrity frameworks and code of ethics. They must follow:

- Probity and rule of law,
- to neither take nor offer bribe,
- to perform all tasks in an honest and transparent manner;
- to act in public interest;
- to lead by example exhibiting integrity in personal behavior;
- to report any incident of corruption to the appropriate agency,

02. As a preventive vigilance aspect, it is directed that the officials are requested to take necessary integrity pledge as available in CVC website <https://pledge.cvc.nic.in>.

03. All the DHs/RDs are requested to kindly take online integrity pledge along with the officials working under them and submit the certificate to the Vigilance Division for record by 29.05.2024. The said pledge is required to be taken by all officials i.e. regular/temporary/outsourced.
