Sub: Scanning of computer systems for virus and bot infection.

1. Cyber Swachhta Kendra (CSK) under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Govt. of India, has shared certain bot removal tools to scan the computer for cybersecurity threats and remove the bots from the infected system.

These tools are available on the website of Cyber Swachhta Kendra under the section 'Security Tools' <https://www.csk.gov.in/security-tools.html>. Officials can use any one of the three tools listed on the aforementioned page to scan their system for security threats.

2. Further, as additional security measure, users are also requested to scan their system using Microsoft Windows Malicious Software Removal Tool. The tool can be downloaded from <https://www.microsoft.com/en-us/download/details.aspx?id=9905>

All the officials of CPCB are requested to scan their computer system using these two tools i.e. CERT-In tools mentioned in Point 1 and Microsoft tool mentioned in Point 2. As this is a critical matter related to information security, all the Divisional Heads are also requested to kindly ensure that officials under them have scanned their system using these two security tools.
