

CIRCULAR

In continuation of the office order no. B-29012/2014-15/ESS dated 11.12.2015 and O/o of even number dated September 14, 2016 regarding Inspections & follow ups and Office order dated 13.12.2016 regarding Inspections, follow-ups & revoking of online monitoring systems and order no. B-190045/RG/CPCB/20016-17 dated 22 March 2017 and B-400(MISC)IPC-III/2016-17, dated March 24, 2017 regarding Surveillance of Industrial Inspection, following instructions & timelines, as detailed shall be strictly followed;

- a) In the event of observation of any industry running its operations without having valid consent, immediate action for closure shall be taken.
- b) The inspection report where sample are not been collected and action is to be initiated based on the field inspection only, shall be reported within 48 hrs.
- c) The inspection report should have clarity so that immediate action shall be taken on the basis of dry report. Disciplinary action would be taken against the inspecting officer for not providing clarity in the inspecting report.

The above instructions are being issued with the approval of the Chairman, CPCB and shall be strictly followed by Regional Directorates and the concerned divisions, Nodal officers at Head Office.
