Sub.: Advisory to adopt Alternative Modes of Travel – reg.

With the advent of critical winter season, air pollution levels are expected to go up, and therefore, it is necessary to take steps for minimizing pollution whenever possible. With rapidly increasing number of personalised vehicles, out of various sources contributing to air pollution, emissions from cars and two wheelers have also become a major contributor.

In view of the above, there is need to discourage excessive use of private vehicles and therefore all CPCB employees are advised to adopt alternative modes of travel while commuting such as sharing rides in a carpool or vanpool, walking, bicycling and maximize use of public transport.
