

Notice Inviting Tender

Subject: Tender for disposal of Old Government Vehicle (LMV)

Central Pollution Control Board(CPCB), Regional Directorate, Bengaluru invites Bids in Sealed Envelopes from interested citizens of India (firms/persons) in proforma, as annexed, for disposal of one old Government Vehicle (LMV) on **“As is where is basis”**. The vehicle is available at the basement of CPCB office premises located at Nisarga Bhavan, 1st floor, 7th D Main, Thimmaiah Road, Shivanagar, Bengaluru- 560 079 and the particulars are given below;

02. Time schedule

- i. The vehicle can be inspected between **10.30 AM to 5.30 PM** on any working day during **25/08/2022 and 13/09/2022**.
- ii. Closing date & time for receipt of Bid: Latest by **14/09/2022 upto 5.30 PM**
- iii. Place for submitting bid: Tender Box kept at the Reception, Central Pollution Control Board, Nisarga Bhavan, 1st floor, 7th D Main, Thimmaiah Road, Shivanagar, Bengaluru – 560 079
- iv. The bid should be prepared in the annexed pro forma and submitted in sealed envelope along with the required bid security amount, as detailed in the terms & conditions below.
- v. The envelopes in which bid documents are submitted should be prominently super-scribed with words **“QUOTATION FOR PURCHASE OF OLD OFFICE VEHICLE”**.
- vi. Bid Opening Date, Time and Venue: Bids shall be opened on **15/09/2022 at 11:30 AM** in the conference hall, Central Pollution Control Board, Regional Directorate, Bengaluru
- vii. The bidder with id proof or their authorized representative (not more than one person) with authorization letter may be present and are free to witness the opening of bids.

03. Terms and conditions:

- i. The vehicle shall be disposed off strictly on “**As is where is basis**” and no guarantee or certificate of its worthiness or quality shall be given by CPCB.
- ii. It shall be the sole responsibility of the successful bidder to shift the vehicle from CPCB premises at his own cost.
- iii. The bids for the vehicle as mentioned above shall be accompanied by a bid Security Amount for **Rs. 3000/-** (Rupees **Three Thousand** only) in the form of Demand Draft / Bankers Cheque/ Pay Order drawn in favour of Central Pollution Control Board, Bengaluru.
- iv. Bids without security amount or Bid Security Amount in any other form i.e., cheque or cash shall not be considered and rejected.
- v. The successful bidder shall be selected on the basis of the Highest Price Quoted and fulfillment of all other criteria and conditions. However, if it is found that the amount quoted by the successful bidder (i.e. highest bidder) is less than the Reserve Price fixed by the Regional Transport Office (RTO) Bengaluru or if the total number of bidders are less than three, the tender process shall be treated as cancelled.
- vi. If the highest quoting firm/person fails to honour the bid; then the offer will be cancelled & their/his Bid Security Amount shall be forfeited. In such an event, an opportunity shall be given to the next highest quoting eligible bidder (H-2 quoting party) to complete the bid formalities, provided it is prepared to accept the price offered by the H-1 party. In case of any dispute, decision of CPCB shall be final.
- vii. Bid Security Amount of the bidders who fail to honour the bid in prescribed time limit (within three working days) shall stand forfeited. No representation in this regard shall be entertained by CPCB. Bid Security Amount will not be adjusted in the Sale Amount accepted by CPCB and Bid Security Amount of successful bidder shall be released only after successful completion of the sale process.
- viii. The bidder has to enclose self-attested copy of Photo identity card/Pan Card/Aadhar Card while submitting the bid, without which the quotation will not be accepted and shall be deemed invalid.
- ix. Bid Security Amount of the bidders rescinding their offer, withdrawing or abrogating after submission of bids shall stand forfeited and decision of CPCB shall be final in this regard.
- x. Bid Security Amount of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned within three weeks of completing the sale process.
- xi. The Chairman, CPCB reserves the right to accept or reject any/all of the bids without assigning any reason thereof.
- xii. The delivery of the sold vehicle will be arranged only after the successful bidder submits documentary evidence in support of residential status viz. Aadhar Card/Voter Identity Card/Passport/Driving License/ Pan card etc., in case of individual and Registration Certificate in case of firms etc.

- xiii.** The successful bidder will have to shift the vehicle at his own cost within three days of final payment, failing which resale of the vehicle will be undertaken at the risk and cost of the defaulter.
- xiv.** The successful bidder will also be responsible for getting the Registration Certificate, Insurance and other documents of the vehicle transferred in his name at his/their own cost expeditiously. CPCB will not be responsible for any lapse on his/their part in this regard.
- xv.** All taxes/levies/Insurance/Registration cost etc. will be borne by the buyer over and above the bid price & CPCB will not bear any of the expenses in this regard.
- xvi.** An affidavit in Rs. 100/- e- stamp paper from Notary shall be submitted by the Bidder providing the details of the full sale/bid amount of the vehicle before taking the possession of the vehicle.
- xvii.** Any employees of CPCB and their family members are not eligible to participate in the bidding process.
