

CERT-IN Empanelled Auditors

Sub – Security Auditing of the CAAQM Applications.

Sir,

This is with regard to the security auditing of web applications of Central Pollution Control Board, an autonomous body under ministry of Environment & Forest. The web applications have been developed by M/s Akal Information System Limited, Delhi.

There are three web applications developed located at the addresses:

2. CAAQM Delhi City: <http://164.100.43.188/cpcbnew/movie.html>, in ASP with Server 2005
3. CAAQM Advisory: <http://164.100.43.188/cpcbpa>, in Dot Net with Server 2005

The scope of work:

- a) Application hosting at NIC Datacentre.
- b) Auditing of vulnerable codes and co-ordination with the application software consultant in removing vulnerabilities, if any,
- c) Providing audit clearance certificate to CAAQM, CAAQM Delhi City & CAAQM Advisory
- d) Installation/shifting at NIC server/ NIC-NET.

Other Terms and Conditions:

- a) The firm should have valid empanelment with CERT-IN.
- b) Auditing to be completed within thirty days from the date of work award letter excluding the developer's Non Conformities closing time.
- c) Payment will be made after getting security audit clearance from NIC and hosting at NIC.
- d) Testing should not disturb the application software and data available. In any case. If observed, firm shall be responsible to correct it immediately.
- e) In case of any dispute, decision of Chairperson, CPCB will be final in all respects.

The applications have been uploaded at the locations having no password. Single MS SQL database is in use for these applications. All three applications have to be hosted on NIC Server, CERT-IN Empanelled auditor firms are hereby requested to give their lowest quote for the security audit of these applications on or before **23rd May'2012, 5:00 PM** in a sealed envelope super scribed as **“Quotations of Security Auditing of CAAQM Applications of CPCB, IT Division”**.
