2. Time Schedule

- i) As there are no original papers of vehicles available, a copy of FIR will be given to the successful bidders during auctioning.
- ii) The vehicle can be inspected between 03:00 P.M. to 04:00 P.M. upto 04.03.2014.
- iii) Closing date & time for receipt of Bid : **by 11:00 A.M. on 07.03.2014.**
- iv) Place for submitting bid : Tender Box will be kept at the Reception, Central Pollution Control Board. The cover of the bid documents should be prominently super-scribed with words "QUOTATION FOR PURCHASE OF CONDEMNED VEHICLE"
- v) Bid Opening Date, Time and Venue : **Same day, soon after the closing time of bidding in the training hall, Central Pollution Control Board.**

03. Terms and conditions :

- i) Bids Security as mentioned above may be in the form of Demand draft / Pay Order drawn in favour of Central Pollution Control Board, New Delhi must be enclosed with the bid. Bids without bid security or in any other form i.e. cheque or cash will not be considered.
- ii) The successful bidder will be required to deposit the bid amount by means of cash on the same day i.e. the date of the acceptance of the bid.

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- iii) If it is found that the amount quoted by the successful bidder (i.e. highest bidder) is less than the reserve price fixed by the Airport Authority of India or the total number of bidders was less than three the bid may be treated as cancel.
- iv) The Earnest Money of the successful bidder will be released only after the deposit of sale proceeds. Earnest Money will be forfeited if he fails to honour the bid.
- v) The delivery of the sold vehicle will be arranged only after the successful bidder submits documentary evidence in support of residential status viz. Ration Card/Voter Identity Card/ Passport in case of individual and Registration Certificate in case of firms etc.
- vi) The successful bidder has to remove the vehicles at his own cost within three days of final payment, failing which resale of the vehicle will be undertaken at the risk and cost of the defaulter.
- vii) The vehicle will be disposed off on as is where basis.
- viii) The successful bidder will also be responsible for getting the Registration Certificate of the vehicle transferred in his name at their own cost expeditiously. The CPCB will not be responsible for any lapse on his part in this regard.
- ix) The bidders will not be allowed to withdraw their bids, failing which their Earnest Money will be forfeited.
- x) The CCB, CPCB reserves the right to accept or reject any/ all of the quotations without assigning any reason.
- xi) All taxes/ levies etc. will be borne by the buyer over and above the bid price.
- xii) Staff and officers of CPCB not eligible to participate in the bidding process.
