5. Make and model number shall be clearly mentioned in the quotation
6. Items to be delivered in full quantity. Part supply will not be accepted. All charges including basic price, VAT, any other tax, and transportation cost etc. should be mentioned clearly.
7. Preference will be given to parties offering on site comprehensive warranty.
8. Test certificate wherever required shall be submitted along with equipment.
9. Duly filled in quotation shall reach this on or before **12<sup>th</sup> December, 2014 at 16.00 hours.** The quotations may be sent by registered post or may also be dropped in the tender box kept at this office.
10. Payment will be made through A/C payee cheque in the name of organisation, after satisfactory supply of all the items.
11. Competent authority in the Board has full right to accept or reject any/all tenders /quotation without assigning any reason thereof.

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### Specification for Personnel Protective Equipment:

S.No	Name of item	Specification
1	Industrial safety helmets	Industrial safety helmets should be of HDPE made inside plastic ratchet type. Meet the standard of IS2925:1984 and DGMS approved
2	Disposable particulate respirator	Cup type respirator for dust protection with double adjustable head band with exhalation vent. It should meet the standard as per IS -9437:2002& DGMS approved.
3	Ear plugs (disposable)	Ear protectors, disposable corded ear plug and should meet the standards of IS-9167:1979.
4	Safety shoes (industrial)	Industrial safety shoes should be made of good quality upper barton grain leather with inside lining split leather with inside lining split leather/synthetic. Foot bed removable polyamide on Eva. Outsole injected single density PU. Low ankle. Anti-rust nickel coated eyelets. Foam padded collar lining. Impregnated non – woven antistatic insole. It should meet the standard of IS:15298 or EN345 ISI or CE marked & approved.
5	Safety gloves (chemical resistant)	The glove should be atlas protective products, acrylonitrile –butadiene rubber unsupported gloves of thickness 0.38 mm, length 33cm with cotton flock lining and pebble grip palm. The gloves should meet the European standard EN 388 for protection against chemicals and microorganism.
6	Safety shoes(gum boots for river monitoring )	PVC gum boots suitable for use against oil & chemical with inside cotton lining comfortable for use in any climate , with steel toe cap and as per standard of IS:12254:1993,ISI marked & approved
7	Safety belts	Full body adjustable harness with two front textile loops, with lanyards “CE marked EN361:2002” with PN251(2.0M) double polyamide rope lanyard 12mm dia with 2 hook (to withstand 140kg and to be shockproof) PN 131 & one hook PN112(2.0M) “CE Marked EN354:2002”.
8	Safety gloves(against heat)	Glove should be full Kevlar glove as the outer shell and a seamless knitted cotton liner inside the outer shell should be made of heavy duty Kevlar seamless knitted glove with additional protection from thermal hazard. The glove should be certified as per European council directive 89/686/EEC or ISI marked
9	Latex soft gloves (microbiology lab)	Surgical power free sterile latex hand gloves, should be CE approved size.
10	Safety goggles	Goggles should meet internationally accepted standards of ANSI Z87.1, for the requirements of high velocity impact, liquid droplets and large dust particles.
11	Laboratory coat	100% cotton laboratory coat for laboratory use
12	Life safety jacket	Life safety jacket should be as per standard under AS 4758 or PFD type - 1 under AS 1512-1996.it should designate to keep the body afloat for

		long periods. It should have reflective tape and a whistle to attract attention.
13	Heat resistant jacket	Jacket for protection against heat & flame as per standards BS EN ISO 11612:2008.
14	Organic gas mask (resistant for acid fumes and organic fumes ) Full / Half	NIOSH approved organic gas respirator against certain organic vapours and acid gases. Material should be of silicone.
15	Fire blanket.	Made of fibre glass as per BS EN 1869. To be supplied along with container.
16	Asbestos gloves	With cotton lining, heat resistance up to 1000°C
17	PVC gloves	With cotton lining resistance to acid, alkali, oil, grease, inorganic salts etc
18	Rubber gloves	Orange / red colour. Resistance to acid/alkali. Heavy duty application
