- a. 166 Municipal Authorities have Garbage Clinic (Solid Liquid Resources Management Centers) for secondary segregation of MSW and 166 Municipal Authorities are operating their own Composting Plant.
- b. Solid Waste Management in 166 ULBs of the State is based on the waste management model (Mission Clean City) currently running successfully in Ambikapur. These Municipal Authorities have collection and transportation facilities for SWM. The source segregated MSW is collected by SHG workers by tricycles and Mini tippers. The MSW facilities are effectively managed and planned to comply the provision of the SWM Rules, 2016.
- c. These 166 Municipal Authorities have Garbage Clinic (Solid Liquid Resource Management Centers) for secondary segregation of MSW and also these 166 Municipal Authorities are operating their own composting plant.
