

Web based Battery Registration Management System (BRMS)

Introduction:

MoEF have notified the Battery (Management & Handling) Rules- 2001 as Amended on May 2010. As per the provision under Rule 5, the importer shall get registered with the Central Pollution Control Board by submitting application in Form-II for a period of five years.

Battery Rules:

The Rules applies to every stack holders such as manufacturer, importer, re-conditioner, assembler, dealer, recycler, auctioneer, consumer and bulk consumer involved in manufacturing, processing, sale, purchase and use of batteries or components thereof.

Battery Registration Management System (BRMS):

Central Pollution Control Board was launched the web based Battery Registration Management System (BRMS) on 1st March, 2013, , in order to improve the efficiency of existing manual processing system and better management of New Lead Acid Battery Importers Registration.

Objective of BRMS:

The BRMS application will help CPCB to online monitoring of Battery registration, processing, grant of registration for importers of New Lead Acid Batteries and submission of half yearly returns. The on-line system will also reduce the time for processing of battery application as well as verification; scrutinization of half yearly returns received from various importers. Tracking of distribution & sale of new batteries, collection of used batteries, transport and reprocessing of used batteries, by registered recyclers and brings out transparency in the system of on-line battery registration.

BRMS Software:

The BRMS software is limited to the use of officials of concerned divisions of Central Pollution Control Boards, SPCBs, Battery importers, Custom authorities as well as Ministry of Environment & Forests (MoEF) Officials.

The web based software, streamlining the process of application submitted by lead acid battery importers to issue registration certificate by verifying the required documents enclosed by importers while applying fresh registration certificate.

Grant of Fresh Registration:

The following procedure shall be followed for acceptance of applications for grant of certificate to importers of new lead acid batteries;

- i. Applicant shall apply for the grant of registration through online web-portal www.cpcbbrms.nic.in
- ii. After submission of online application, applicant shall also submit physical copy of application on their letter head, enclosing following documents;
 - a. Printouts of Form II and Form III taken out from online application with their stamp and signature on the same.
 - b. Self-attested copy of Import-Export certificate
- iii. The complete application will be processed within 7 days from receipt of manual/hard copy.
- iv. Registration will be issued only on the corporate address or branch address specified on IEC certificate.
- v. In-Charge HWM Division will grant the registration to importers of new lead acid batteries.
- vi. The importer registered earlier by MoEF&CC desirous to get registered with CPCB, may apply for the same as above. However, they shall surrender original registration certificate issue by MoEF&CC along with their application.

Documents to be verified:

- Online submission of Fresh/Renewal of the registration by the new lead acid battery importers.
- Incomplete applicants will be informed to submit the requisite document for further processing.
- Online submission of half yearly returns by importers as per the rule as well as verification of returns by the CPCB officials/Port authority.
 - ✚ Generation of various reports as per the user requirement.
 - ✚ To keep provision for future expandability/integration with any national policy for implementation of Battery rules in the country.

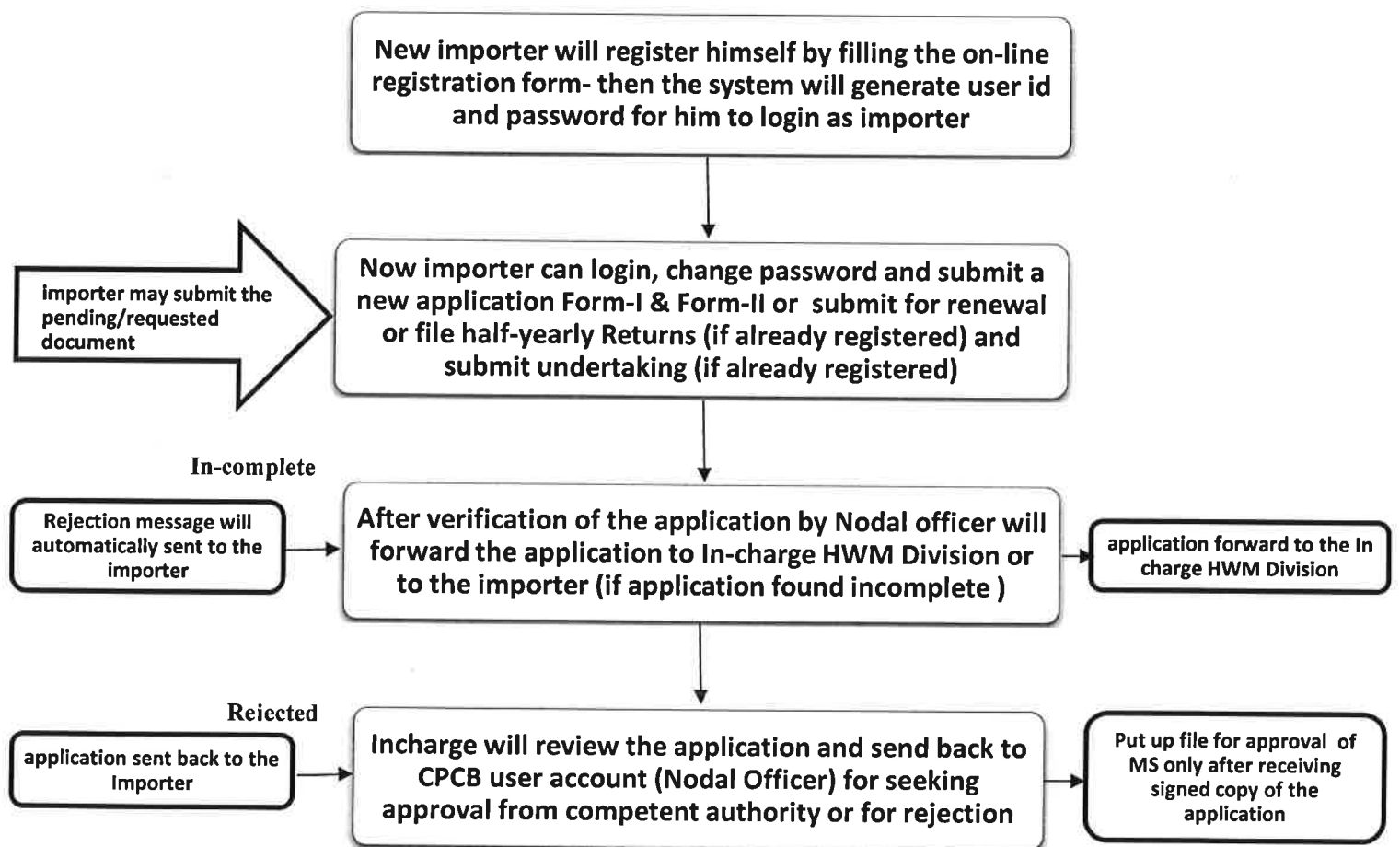
Mechanism of the Project & Deliverables:

The BRMS will be web based and user friendly. Following activities will be covered in the system:

- ✚ Online Registration of Battery Importers
- ✚ Submission of Half Yearly Return By Battery Importers

- ✦ Processing and verification of fresh/renewal applications based on half yearly returns received.
- ✦ Issue of Grant/Rejection letter by CPCB to importers
- ✦ Generation of various reports like application status details, half yearly return, follow of action and other reports as per the CPCB requirement.
- ✦ Online Status of application received, Registration granted, detail of incomplete applications and application rejected.
- ✦ Access to port authorities to verify the registration status and evaluation of half-yearly returns filed by the importers of new lead acid batteries.

Overall Process Flow Chart of BRMS

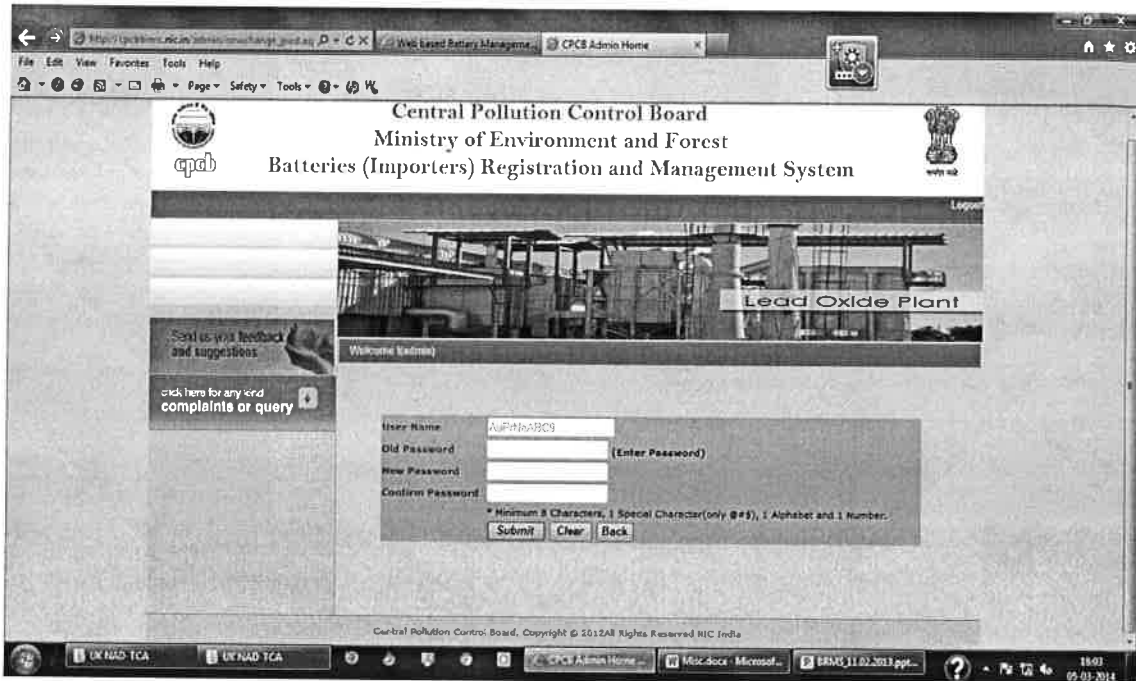

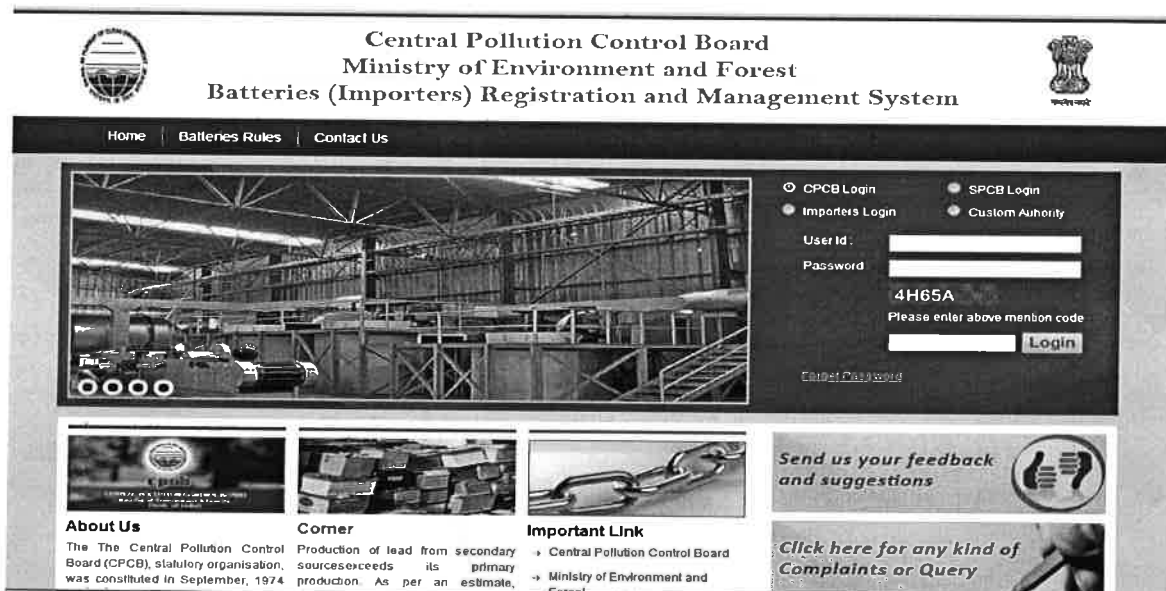
